




It appears from the Size Roll of 1st Troop that Corporal Wm Davis enlisted for ye war in Baylors [George Baylor W5966] Dragoons June 81 & Continued untill ye Mutiney May 83

Baylors Dragoons
Oct'r 18th 1785

Frederick County Oct'r 2^d 1785

Gent'm Commissioner Be so good as to send my [several illegible words] Warrant as I was a Soldier in the 3^d [undeciphered] Dragoons and you'l [undeciphered word] Oblige your Humble [undeciphered] To the Gentlemen Commissioners at Rich[mon]d
NB. Send it to me by Mr John Ribby[?]

A handwritten signature in cursive script that reads "Wm Davis".

NOTE: In South Carolina in May 1783 Virginia Continental dragoons, impatient to return home, commandeered horses rather than wait for ships.
