William Davis [illegible] in the 10<sup>th</sup> Virginia Regiment having Served the term [several undeciphered words] He is hereby discharged from any further Service in the Continental Army. Given at Chesterfield[?] this 31<sup>st</sup> Oct'r 1780 William Davies [BLWt597-500]

Dinwiddie County: March 2<sup>d</sup> 1784

I do hereby certify that William Davis was drafted into the american service as a regular Soldier for the Term of three years, which draft took place early in the Month of September 1777. his discharge will shew from that date the term of his Service. Given under my hand the said second day of March 1784 Banister Lt. Col. [John Banister, Dinwiddie County Militia]
