These are to Certify that Joseph Davison formerly a Soldier in the 1st Virginia Regiment has duly and faithfully served the term of three years for which he was Inlisted in Consequence of which and at his own request he is hearby discharged from any further service in the Army of the United States

Given under my hand at Philadelphia this 27th day of January 1780


