[The following is from [rejected claims in the Library of Virginia](#) indexed as Delastati, Selby.]

Zadock Bayly [S37696] made oath before me that he was drafted for 18 months in April 1781 & after crossing the bay he reinlisted to serve for the term of during the War & did serve till July 1783 & was discharged on condition of serving again if called for & that Selby Delastatious was drafted at the same time & was in the same Company & after crossing the bay s'd Selby Delastatious reinlisted for & served to the end of the war as a private – He further testifies that in 1784 he rece'd a warrant for 200 acres for his (said Baylys) services & is now a Revolutionary pensioner as witness my hand at Accomack CH Va
