


Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

I do hereby Certify that Zachariah Delong Inlisted with me as a Soldier in the Eighth Virginia Regt. for three years and died a prisoner in Phil'a jail in Feb'y 1778 as Witness my hand this 22<sup>d</sup> day of Dec'r. 1795
