



I hereby Certify that Thomas Denton, a Serjeant in the Western Battallion, under my command, served from the 21st[?] of December 1779, untill the 21st of Dec'r 1781 at which time the Regement was discharged agreeably to Law. Given under my hand this 18th day of November 1790
