I Robert Slaughter [VAS426] of the County of Mercer & State of Kentucky a Lieutenant in the third Virginia Regiment upon Continental establishment in the Revolutionary war Do cirtify that I enlisted the aforesaid James Dicken into Capt. John Thornton's [BLWt1870-450] Company in the said third Virginia Regiment to serve three years or during the war, that the said James Dicken died in service some time after his said enlistment & that the John Dicken mentioned in the aforesaid Power of Attorney is the Brother & heir or one of the heirs of the said James, to the best of my knowledge & recollection.
