Westmoreland County State of Virginia To Wit

Be it known that Before me Robert Bailey A Justice of the peace in and for the county aforesaid personally appeared Bennett McKey [S38197] and old Revolutionary Soldier and pensioner of the united States and made oath in due form of Law that he was well acquainted with James Donahaw and was with him in The Revolutionary War in Regular Service for the full space of three years and nine months and do well know that the said Donahaw was Regularly discharged at the close of the War Given under my hand this first day June 1831
