Will. Dowell a Soldier in Lt Colo Campbells [Richard Campbell BLWt347-450] Compy of the 9th Virg'a Regt who was Inlisted to Serve the term of three years in the Cont'l Army & has Served out his time as a good & faithfull Soldier and is Now intituled to his discharge & is hereby discharged accordingly.

Given under my hand this first day of 1 March 1780 at Fort Pitt.


