AGreeable to a Resolution of Congress, bearing Date the 26th Day of May, 1783, the Bearer hereof William Dupee of the 1^t Cavalry Regiment has leave of Absence until called upon by proper authority to join his Corps, or is finally discharged.

Charles Town [Charleston SC] July 3^d 1783

About two months before the battle of the Cowpens [17 Jan 1781] inlisted for the war with Bowyer
