


Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

I do Certify that Michael Eckhart enlisted as a Soldier in the Legionary Corps Commanded by Colo. Armand [Charles Armand BLWt2291-850] for Three years and that he served faithfully as such, untill he was discharged at or about the fifteenth day of November 1783 at York Town Pennsylvania. That he was at the time of his Enlisting and still is a Citizen of Virginia. Given under my hand this first day of March 1798.
