This is to Certifie that Ellis Edwards Inlisted with me the 11 day of march One Thousand seven hundred and seventy Eight to serve in the Navy service, and served the term of Three years which term of three years he discharged his duty truly and faithfully and is hereby Discharged Given under my hand this 11th day of March 1781.
