Virginia Jefferson County Sct.

I Isaac Israel [VAS1353] do hereby Certify that that William Engle inlisted as a Soldier during the revolutionary war some time in the year 1776 in Berkeley County in a company then Commanded by the late Gen'l. William Darke [BLWt598-500], in which Company I was then a Lieutenant, that said company proceeded from Berkeley County to the northward, and that said William Engle died in the service [undeciphered word] a [undeciphered word] the month after he enlisted. That the aforesaid Company was attached to the Regiment Commanded by Col'l. Peter Mullenburgh [sic: Peter Muhlenberg BLWt1495-850].
