The affidavit of Leonard Shackelford [S6085] of the County of King and Queen and State of Virginia This affiant being duly sworn according to law, states upon oath that he is a revolutionary pensioner, going on Seventy six year of age, and that he was well acquainted with David Farinholt late of the County of King and Queen and State of Virginia. that the said Farinholt Enlisted in the revolutionary war as a private, some time in the year 1779 for three years or during the War, in Capt [Theodorick] Bland's troop of horse, and went to the South, but does not know to which regiment the said Farinholt belonged, and further this affiant saith not.
