
[The following is from [bounty-land records in the Library of Virginia](#). The soldier's surname is not clear in the document. The name may actually have been Edward Fathom.]

Winchester Barracks 8th July 1783

Certified that Edward Fathorn inlisted in the Virginia Continantal Line the Twenty fifth of December 1780 for and during the present War. And is now in Actual Service. Given Under my hand the date & place above.
