State of Virginia } S.S.
Culpeper County }

On this 23rd day of June 1835 before the subscriber a justice of the peace in and for the said county personally appeared Peter Triplett [Peter H. Triplett W2706] of said County aged 81 years and of good character for veracity who being duly sworn deposeth and saith that he was well acquainted with John Favors late of Culpeper who died some 30 years since. That he and said Favors enlisted into the service under Capt Benjamin Roberts [S31343] as part of Major Slaughter's [George Slaughter W8729] Battalion for the Western Service. That they marched soon after to the falls of Ohio [Louisville KY]. That said Favors continued with the troops, but to the recollection of affiant he was not in any engagement owing to the indisposition of himself and his family. That said Favors continued with the troops till they were discharged which was about the close 1781 when there was no further need for men. Given under my hand this day and year first above written. O. N. Pemberton J.P.
