Personally appeared before me [page damaged] Mason a justice of the peace for the County
[page damaged]said Thomas Whitehorn, who was a Soldier in the service of the State of Virginia, and
made Oath, that Isham Felts enlisted for three years in the service of the Revolutionary War in said State,
under Capt. James Mason, and was Sergeant of said Company. Given under my hand 29th day of October
1830 Henry Mason JP
