I, Jacob Flornoy [Jacob Flournoy S8492] of Chesterfield County Va. do hereby Certify that I was well acquainted with William Furgarson we bouth were in the same Company which was Capt Thomas Clay [VAS2170], in the Second Regiment of Virginia Artilery Commanded by Col. Marshal [sic: Thomas Marshall VAS494] I know that he enlisted for three years and served the same in the war of the Revolution given under my hand this the 19th day of March 1833
