I do hereby certify that John H. Fitzgerald entered into the service of the United States on Continental Establishment, under the command of Colo. William Crawford [BLWt921-500], in the month of March, one thousand seven hundred and seventy six, and was promoted thereafter, to the Rank of a Captain, in which capacity he acted to the end of the late War with Great Britain



Fitzgerald of the Virg'a line on Continental Establishment having drawn his bounty in land for seven years Service I have at the instance of his Representatives inclosed voucers in order to obtain for him, the additional quantity over and above the seventh year, being about eight months.
