This may Certify that Major John Fitzgerald was Major of the third Virginia Regiment on Continental establishment when he was appointed Aid-de-Camp to his Excellency Gen'l. Washington in the fall of 1776 – that he served in the army from Feb'ry 1776 till the Spring 1779 when he obtained leave of absence on furlough subject to be call for whenever the General thought proper.
