
I do Certify that John Flax enlisted in Major Nelsons [Thomas Nelson W5414] Corps of Cavalry the 2<sup>d</sup> of August 1779 for the War which time he hath served sucessively and is now discharged Given under my hand this 2 day of May 1783

W Graves [William Graves R14570] Cornet VLD

I do Certify that Jhon flax has been inlisted in August 2<sup>th</sup> 1779 wharein he is entiteled tho his land by an act of assembly. Given under my hand at Hampton this 7 day of April one thousand Seven hundred and Eighty three.
