This claim has been reported good for the war in printed list no 4. Isham Floyd enlisted before April 1<sup>st</sup> 1781 and is entitled to three hundred acres of land.

March 18<sup>th</sup> 1834

To his Excellency/ The Governor

The heirs of Isham Floyd respectfully ask of the Executive of Va that they may be allowed land for the services of the s'd Floyd in the Illinois regiment and refer for proof of service to the report of John H Smith the commissioner
