I do here by Certify that Richard Foster served in the last revolutionary war in the seventh Virginia Regiment for the Term of three years in the Capacity of an Audigent [sic: Adjutant] under the command of Colo. Alexander McClanhanan [sic: Alexander McClenachan VAS2033] in Cap'n. Holt Richeson [VAS1954] Company Given under my hand this first day of January 1810.
