King William County ss

I do hereby Certify that Susanna Frail made oath before me a Justice of the peace for the said County that Sally Frail is the Legal Representative of Charles Frail who died in the Continental Army in the year 1777 given under my hand this [missing] Day of June 1789 Th's. Robinson

I do Assign to William [several undeciphered words] Charles Frailes pay of depreciation & land for his services in the army
