Hampton May 29 1779


Received of Capt. John Mazarett [R16059] Twenty dollars in full of the bounty allowed by act of Assembly [several undeciphered words] I hereby [one or two undeciphered words] myself to be regularly enlisted to serve in the said regiment for three years.

I hereby certify that I have received Michael Frederick, enlisted by Capt John Mazarett, to serve for three years in the State regiment of Artillery, and that I think him an able bodied man & fitt for the service
