This is to Certifie that george Frisket inlisted in may 1777 in the 12<sup>th</sup> Virg'a Reg't for three yeares which time he served faithfully and then inlisted for the war given under my hand this 19<sup>th</sup> of July 1783

I Do hereby Certify that george Friskett a Resident of this County Personally assigned & Delivered the above order together with a Certificate of his Enlistment unto the above Named Mr. Henry Funk, in my Presence the day & date above written Alexander Hite a Justice of the peace for the said County.

I do Certify that the within George Frisk enlisted for the war, and served till the Conclusion of it.
