


Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

I do hereby certify that Temple Froman a Soldier in the Continental Army Under Capt. Holt Richeson [VAS1954] in the Seventh Virginia Regiment which was commanded by Alexander McClanaham [sic: Alexander McClenachan VAS2033] served the full term of Three years. Given under my hand this 12<sup>th</sup> day Jan'y 1815

to said Reg't.
