I certify that I was well acquainted with Joseph Frost who enlisted as a Soldier in the army of the Revolution in or about the year 1777 as well as I remember under a Capt [Thomas] Davis of the ninth Regiment of the Virginia line I believe he served more that three years and was Honourably discharged from the service

Given under my hand and seal this 13th day of December 1832 P. Lugg

Norfolk County to wit

The above named Peter Lugg this day personally appeared before me a Justice of the Peace for the County aforesaid and made Oath that the above statement is true as he verily believes

Given under my hand and seal this 13th day of December 1832 Arthur Emmerson J.P.

I certify that Peter Lugg who has signed the above Certificate is about Sixty nine years old is a person in whose statement full reliance is placed by all who know him
