


Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

Virginia documents pertaining to William Garner VAS3683

[The following are from [bounty-land records in the Library of Virginia](#). Another document in the file is undeciphered. This may be the same soldier as William Garner VAS3682.]

William Garner having served as a good Soldier in Capt [undeciphered] Hamiltons Company of the 2nd Virg'a State Reg't [see endnote] for the term of three years is hereby discharged from further service in s'd Regiment  
Given under my hand at Frederick Town this 5 day of Jan'y 1781 [undeciphered word]

I do hereby [the rest undeciphered] Wm Garner

Please to be so kind to Settle with Mr John Green the Certificat of William garner if is any thing due him  
you will oblige your most obed't servt/ Alexander [undeciphered]

NOTE: Thomas Hami.lton was a captain in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Virginia State Regiment. His company was raised in Fairfax County.
