I do hereby Certify that Captain Erasmus Gill entered into service in the Second Virginia Regiment on the [illegible word] 9<sup>th</sup> of September 1775 and continued in the continental army until the 1<sup>st</sup>[?] of March 1783 And I do further [undeciphered word] that during the time aforementioned he constantly continued in service and that he not at any time either superceded or cashiered. Given under my hand this 30<sup>th</sup> June 17[illegible]
