This is to Certify that Thomas Gist formerly a soldier in the 4<sup>th</sup>[?] Virginia Regiment has duly and faithfully served the term of three years in the Continental service being the time for which he enlisted in the service of the united states and at his own request he is hereby discharged from any other service in army of the united states and [undeciphered word] return [undeciphered word] and unmolested he haveing received all his bounty pay and clothing and dipetiency [depreciation?] of pay and clothing allowed by Congress for the troopes
