State of [Kentucky] Nelson County Sct [10 Nov 1842]

Personally came before me Elijah Davis a justice of the Peace a said County of Nelson Mr. Moses Harrel Wm Weathers and Nancy Harrel and made oath that the statements in the foregoing memorial are true to the best of their knowledge and belief & hereto I set my name

Elijah Davis J Peace

Frankfl[?] Ky/ June 22nd 1846

To The Hon Executive Of Virginia/ Dr Sir

Having learned that the time has been extended by your Legislature in which application for allowances of Land Bounty can be made, I have the honor herein to enclose you a memorial of the heirs of James Graham a Soldier of the Illinois Regiment praying an allowance of the quantity to which he acquired a right on account of his services in said Regiment.

You will please inform me of the allowance when granted. Direct to me at Frankfl Ky
