Received of Mr Francis [undeciphered] and Mr Nat'l Buckhanan of the County of Chesterfield, a certain Joel Grissel enlisted as a Soldier to serve the term of three years, agreeable to an act of General Assembly for the more orderly completing the Quota of Troops to be raised in the Commonwealth, for the [undeciphered] Reg't of the Continental Army Given under my hand this the 28<sup>th</sup> day of August AD 1777
