[undeciphered] 12th March 1777


These are to Certify that William Thomas Formerly a Soldier in the 3^d Virginia Regiment, has duly and faithfully served the term of years for which he was enlisted in consequence of which he is hereby Discharged from any further Service in the Army of the United States, and Permitted to return to his home free and unmolested, he having Received all his Bounty pay & Clothing & Deficiency of pay and Clothing [one or two undeciphered words] of all allowances & provision made by the Congress in their [undeciphered word] – and Receipt of which is on the Back hereof.

Given under my hand Philidilphia this 27th Day of Jan'y 1780.


