


Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

[The following are from [rejected claims in the Library of Virginia](#) misfiled with papers pertaining to William Holeman that are mostly illegible.]

The affidavit of Edward Herndon [VAS1505], who having been duly sworn upon the holy evangelist of Almighty god deposeth and saith that at [undeciphered] Commencement of the War of the Revolution he enlisted as a soldier in the Company raised & commanded by Capt. Samuel Woodson of the County of Goochland and that George Herndon was also a Soldier in the said Company, and died in the service of his Country in the 9th Virginia Regiment
