

I do certify that Elias Honey Matross in my Company was inlisted by Lieut Langham [Elias Langham S41747] of Colo Charles Harrison's [VAS1411] Reg't of Artillery the second day of Feb'y 1782 to serve during the war and that he served faithfully untill the end of the war
