[The following is from [rejected claims in the Library of Virginia](#) indexed as Ridley, Peter.]

Warwick County towit

This day Thomas R. Dunn aged 66 years & who is a justice of the peace for the said County, personally appeared before me W. S. Jones a justice of the peace for the said County & made oath that during the war of the Revolution he was well acquainted with Peter Ridley, Enos Dunn, Samuel Jones & John Jones, and lived in the same neighbourhood with them; that the said Peter Ridley & others above named joined the army of the revolution and enlisted under Captain Nelson [probably Thomas Nelson, Jr.] and marched to the north, except John Jones who enlisted under Captain Dickinson [probably Edmund B. Dickinson, BLWt523-400]; The said Thomas R Dunn further deposes that the said Peter Ridley, Enos Dunn & Samuel Jones never returned, and that they died in service at the north; John Jones did return and lived in this county many years after the war. Given under my hand this 16th of October 1833.
