
Virginia documents pertaining to Alexander Keith VAS3903

I certify that I was very well acquainted with Alexander Keith who served in the Virginia line on continental establishment during the war of our revolution. He engaged in the third Virginia Regiment in which he was appointed a Sergeant in January or february 1776 & in the autumn of that year was appointed a lieutenant in the company commanded by Captain Thomas Blackwell [S35193] in the 10<sup>th</sup> Virginia regiment afterward the sixth in which he continued during the war. I was appointed at the same time & served as second Lieutenant in the same company
