


Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

Gents Fauquier the 9th of March 1795
I have to beg the favour of you to Certify to Colo'n Markham that that I am entitled to A Midshipmans
Quota of Land due for Naval services which Certificates you have in your office from under Capt
Markham's hand. Mr John Hogwood obliges
I am Gent'n your ob'd & H'm Servt,
Howson Kenner

I do certify that Mr Howson Kenner enlisted with me in the State Navy the twentieth day of Aug't 1777
& served as a sailor till the 1st day of July 1779 [several illegible words] midshipman [several illegible
