Also, dates or numbers which the software treats as numerals rather than words are not corrected: for example, the software transcribes "the eighth of June one thousand eighty six" as "the 8th of June 1786." This is to Certify that I was in the Revolution with Abraham Buford & at the time of his Deafeet [May 29, 1780, Battle of the Waxhaws] in Carrolinia [South Carolina], which I acted In the Capassity [capacity] of a quarter Master Seargant, & I know Sharach Hensin very well, he was a Soldier under Buford at the Same time on what Terms he Sarve in the Army; I do not know, Given under my hand this 24<sup>th</sup> day of Sept. 1810
