I do certifie that Thomas Kent Enlisted with me on or about the 17th of July 1777 for the term of three years Witness my hand Thos. Pollard [undeciphered word] [Thomas Pollard VAS229]

Entitled to depreciation for three years commutation July Seventy seven
If not settled Aug't 8 86 T Meriwether

I do certifie that the within Thos. Kent served out the time for which he was engaged and was dischargd at hampton at the end of s'd Service, he says he has lost or mislaid the discharge he got. I well remember of seeing it.
