seaman in The State Navy and oblige yr H<sup>le</sup> Ser<sup>t</sup> Wm his Xmark Kent  
Aud<sup>rs</sup> of pub<sup>k</sup> acc<sup>t</sup> Feb<sup>y</sup> 2<sup>d</sup> 86
