King & Queen County 2^d Feby 1808

Thomas Lipscomb entered with Capt Holt Richeson [VAS1954] of the 7th Virginia Reg't as cadet, in the month of March 1776, soon after he was promoted to an Ensigny & remained in line until the beginning of the year One Thousand Seventy [sic] hundred & seventy nine, at which time s'd Lipscomb resigned his Commission. Given under my hand the date above.
