That the bearer John Locke was a Corporal in my Comp'y of Infantry and Inlisted for the war Captured at Charles Town [Charleston SC, 12 May 1780] and while there received Two Dollars. There was previous to that time paid up to Decem. 1779 and Continued in Service until the General Discharge of the Army of the United States by Congress. Certified by John Curry Capt 4 Virg'a Reg
Augusta March 7 1784
