Winchester Barracks May 2<sup>d</sup> 1783

I do Certify that Serjeant Christopher McCannan Inlisted in the service of the United States the 20<sup>th</sup> of Aug't 1776 and have Continued in Service ever Since Given under my hand the date above mentioned  
Sam'l Booker Capt [Samuel Booker BLWt315-300]  
2 Virg'a Reg't  
P Muhlenberg BG [Peter Muhlenberg BLWt1495-850]

[undeciphered] for Fauquier County [illegible] March 17[??]  
Christopher McCannon made oath [illegible] the within is an authentic and [illegible] Certificate and that he has never [illegible] before procured[?] or claimed his right [illegible] land for the service therein mentioned which is ordered to be certified H Brooks

We certify that Christopher McCannon enlisted some time in the Spring 1776 to serve in the Marine Service afterwards reenlisted in the first Virg'a State Regimt for three years & Continued in Service until the time elaps'd.
