Westmoreland County State of Virginia To Wit

Be it known that Before me Robert [illegible] a Justice of the peace in and for said county personally appeared Job Self aged [illegible] and made oath in due form of law that he was well acquainted with Jeremiah McCluskey and knows that the said McCluskey enlisted under Capt George Turberville [George Lee Turberville (Turberville) BLWt2153-300] in the commencement of the Revolutionary War for and during the War and [several undeciphered words] believes that the said McCluskey was [undeciphered] Slain in Battle or died in the army as he never returned to his Relations [undeciphered] Given under my hand this 12 May 1831
