At a Court held for James City County Sept'r 11th 1786
a Certificate from Colo. J. Allison [John Allison W4112] of John McDougal having served as a Drummer
three years in the first Virginia State Regiment, and another Certificate from [undeciphered] a Justice of
the said County of the said McDougal's having made Oath before him of his never beforee [undeciphered]
or claiming his Right to Land for the Service aforesaid, were produced [illegible] and ordered to be
certified & [undeciphered] Ben C Waller C.C.
