At a Court held for James City County June the 12<sup>th</sup> 17[??] a Certificate from Colo. William Brent [VAS2639] of Thomas Manfield having served as a Soldier in the second State Regiment the Term of his enlistment & after being properly discharged And another Certificate from James McClung Gent one of the Justices of York County of the said Mansfield having made oath before him, that he never before proved or claimed his Right to Land for his said Military service were produced & read & ordered to be certified & recorded
