

I do certify that John Martin inlisted with me the 7th day of Feby 1780 to serve as a matross in Col'n Charles Harrison's [Charles Harrison VAS1411] Reg't of Artillery during the War, in which Reg't he has faithfully served and has not received one shilling of his pay.
