King William County to Wit state of Virginia

This day John Lipscomb [W5323] of said County came before me one of the Commonwealth Justices of the peace for the County aforesaid and made Oath that William Merrick dec'd who died the 29<sup>th</sup> day of January 1821 was a private Soldier in our old Revolutionary War (Seventy six) in the Continentel line, he Served a Tour duty Three years, as a faithful Soldier. He was a very poor man & died as such leaveing four or five small Children given under my hand this 25<sup>th</sup> day of March 1822.
